INDUSTRY REQUIREMENTS

- High School diploma or GED.
- Previous experience in surface preparation and coatings applications for commercial, industrial or residential painting.
- Journey Level status or willing to take a skills test to determine level of expertise. (Wages are based on levels of expertise.)
- Knowledge of the paint industry safety regulations including personal protective equipment and respirator usage.
- Employers may require pre-employment drug testing and background checks.
